Introduction

ICGN overall impression is that the proposed Stewardship Code provides a helpful starting framework and addresses many of the essential components of effective stewardship. A key benefit of the proposed Code is that it provides a formal structure that should improve the ability of asset owners to hold asset managers to account. This is consistent with the UK Myners Principles, which encourage pension fund trustees to hold their asset managers and intermediaries accountable.

This Breakfast Talk aims to share and highlight on the faithful and consistent application of a well-developed Stewardship Code by a critical mass of institutional investors would enhance board and management accountability by UK listed companies and contribute to realising the Code's objectives of improving long-term returns to shareholders while reducing the risk of catastrophic outcomes due to bad strategic decisions.
